The CLIMATEFIT replication programme is now open for applications! We invite local and regional public authorities to participate in a structured learning process aimed at scaling up climate adaptation financing strategies and establishing Local Resilience Taskforces (LRTs). Selected participants will benefit from mentorship, capacity-building workshops, and direct engagement with experienced territories and financial experts to advance their climate adaptation initiatives.

Why participate?

- Access to expertise Learn from leading specialists in climate adaptation financing.
- ✓ <u>Innovative solutions</u> Gain insights into financing mechanisms and investment strategies.
- <u>Tailored support</u> Receive structured guidance on establishing LRTs and developing investment plans.
- Networking & peer learning Connect with other territories and exchange best practices.

Who can apply?

- ✓ Local & regional public authorities (cities, municipalities, metropolitan areas).
- ✓ <u>Public organizations supporting public authorities</u> (climate agencies, development agencies, etc.).
- Entities with a clear commitment to advancing climate adaptation financing and strategy development.

Programme structure

Participants will join three online replication workshops and voluntary advanced programme:

- * Step 1 Getting started: An online workshop (2-4 hours) where participants are introduced to CLIMATEFIT's key principles, exchange on their local adaptation and financing challenges, and learn from mentors about initial lessons and barriers in adaptation finance.
- ★ <u>Step 2 Working together</u>: An online workshop (2-4 hours) focused on the Local Resilience Taskforce (LRT) model, exploring how it can accelerate resilience investments and facilitate collaboration between public authorities and financial entities.
- ★ Step 3 Moving forward: An online workshop (2-4 hours) dedicated to making adaptation projects more bankable, applying CLIMATEFIT methodologies for investment strategies and financing solutions, and fostering regional and international collaboration.
- ★ Bonus Voluntary advanced programme: A tailored mentorship opportunity for experienced replicators with concrete adaptation projects, providing on-demand exchanges with experts on financing mechanisms and LRT development.
